Fernando Lopez, James Kirk, Noel Gorgas and Josiah Sherrow of **Creative Graphic Solutions** in Portage, Ind., created this wrap for Servpro of LaPorte County.

“ServPro was looking for an effective way to further brand their company’s local branch here in the Midwest. We have a bunch of lakes and a bunch more fishermen. ServPro liked the idea of sponsoring a local angler, and decided to sponsor and wrap a boat. We started with an overall corporate look for design. After approval it was off to the races with print and install. The install was tricky, but the finished product was great and the client was happy.”

The project took 12 hours total to design and install. The wrap was done with OraJet 3951 and Oraguard 290 laminate on a Roland SJ 745EX, with no premask and lots of 3M Primer 94.



Jean Carson and two employees of **FASTSIGNS** in Henderson, Nev., did these cars for Focus Brand Group as part of a giveaway. The cars were displayed in the MGM Grand casino and all went to their winners in different states.

The job was done on an HP 8000 printer, using 3M IJ 180Vv3 with 3M Luster Laminate. Carson says the vehicles were finished in about two weeks.
